<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When you find a nest or young, stay only long enough to make a mental note of the details, then leave the area to record your observations. Do not touch nests, eggs, or young birds. • Use one card for each nest or family group. • Include as much detail as possible when filling out cards. • This card is designed for a single visit or observation: if you make repeat visits to a nest, record dates under "Details". <p>Definitions</p> <p>Active Nest - use this category when you cannot determine the contents of a nest but other factors indicate that eggs or young are present. For example, a bird repeatedly carrying food to a nest cavity, or an adult bird sitting on a nest. Describe what you observed under "Details"</p> <p>Local Young - young which have recently left the nest and are not yet capable of sustained flight.</p> <p>Distraction Display - feigning injury to lure you away from eggs or young.</p>
