Raphael, aged 12, is a native Yukoner. He became hooked on birds on an extended family trip to Central America. His life list is now over 400 species, seen in Nicaragua, Costa Rica, Belize, Québec, and the Yukon.

Madeleine, Raphael's mother, was raised in a family where natural history occupied an important place. She came to birding while accompanying her son on excursions and trips in order to allow him to fulfil his passion.

Jean, Madeleine's father, lives in Québec City. He has been birding for 48 years, mostly in

Québec, British Columbia and, since 2006, the Yukon – where he enjoyed yearly birding trips with Helmut Grünberg until his passing. Jean is keenly interested in citizen science, as a participant in the Québec and BC breeding bird atlases, and running more than 200 Breeding Bird Survey routes in Québec as a volunteer for the Canadian Wildlife Service.
